Take home trophies will be awarded to the first three boats on corrected time in each class. In addition, the winner of each of the long standing Yesteryear Regatta Perpetual Trophies will be announced. AMSS will once again hold its popular raffle of items donated by local businesses.

Racers are invited to moor at the front dock of SDYC Friday night for the pre race dockside informal gathering and Saturday night for post race activities.
