NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2009 - 2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 The prescriptions of US Sailing will not apply except the US Sailing Prescriptions to rules 68, 76.1 and added rule 76.3.

1.3 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

1.4 If there is a conflict between rules or regulations, other than RRS, the Sailing Instructions will prevail.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising at this event is restricted per ISAF regulation 20.3.1.2 (formerly Category A) pursuant to the ISAF Advertising Code and Ancient Mariners Sailing Society Rules. The Organizing Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising.

3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

3.1 Entry is open to all active skippers and owners of the PC Class, the PCC class, all Kettenburg boats built prior to 1970, the Ancient Mariners Sailing Society, and all other full keel boats of all wood hull construction built prior to 1970.

3.2 Entries shall be made on line at <http://www.sdyc.org/kettenburg>. No entries will be accepted after June 23, 2010 at 17:00. No entry can be considered final until verified by the Ancient Mariners Sailing Society Association.

3.3 All yachts are required to show proof of current Third Party Liability insurance. Each skipper or co-skipper is liable for any and all third party personal injury and property damage claims. It is strongly recommended that each yacht be covered by appropriate and adequate Third Party Personal Injury and Property Damage Liability Insurance of not less than \$300,000.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$5 per foot (LOA) if received prior to June 15, 2011. After this date the entry fee shall be \$10 per foot. Payment shall be made online by credit card, member account or you may mail a check (made out to The Kettenburg & Classic Yacht Regatta). The entry fee includes docking during the regatta, the Concours D' Elegance, racing and all social events for skipper and one crew. Social packages for additional crew and guests will be available.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and will be posted on the event web site as soon as available.

7. VENUE

7.1 Regatta headquarters will be at the San Diego Yacht Club, San Diego, CA.

7.2 The racing area will be in the Pacific Ocean west of Coronado Island in the area called Coronado Roads and in the San Diego Bay.

8. THE COURSES

The courses will be as set out in the Sailing Instructions.

9. SCORING

9.1 The Low Point scoring system utilizing the Ancient Mariners Sailing Society Handicaps will apply.

9.2 Three races are scheduled, two of which will be sailed on the Coronado Roads and one of which will be sailed in San Diego Bay.

9.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

Spectator and other support boats shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the warning signal until the end of the last race of the day. Specific spectator and support boat instructions will be stated in the Sailing Instructions.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12.2 The race committee intends to use VHF marine radio frequencies to broadcast courtesy information to competitors.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be given for each class. Prizes shall also be given for Concours D' Elegance event.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Basic Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
