Saturday May 9th “Race Day”

Race day was very busy as usual in the morning with registration and the skippers meeting. We secured a fleet of 35 boats.

This year the conditions favored the high handicap and powerful reaching yachts. A change from last year that favored the close winded boats which was a change from the 2012 and 2013 YJR's that favored the less close winded, higher handicapped yachts.

Highlights of race day for me included:

- Seeing Leslie sell lots of hats and prompting AMSS membership at the Skippers Meeting.
- Seeing Caroline sell reams of raffle tickets at the skippers meeting and then having Reese, Corral and Mary track down additional raffle ticket buyers after the race on the docks and at the awards presentation.

- Seeing the pack of boats at the leeward mark and last leg of the race knowing it would be a close race after the corrections.

- Seeing a nice mixing of the Classes in the Overall Standings.
- Seeing close Corrected Times in the Classes. Class A 1st -3rd was only 9 seconds. Class C also very close.

- Seeing the **Hidalgo** not start properly and taking a DNS after sailing down from LA for the race.
- Having a protest, that still needs to be heard so the results can be finalized.
- Forgetting to thank Lynn Eddy and the SWYC RC at the post awards gathering and not presenting her RC a Race Packet and Poster for the 41st YJR.
