



The Ancient Mariners Sailing Society in conjunction with San Diego Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority (OA) for this event.

June 22-24, 2018 NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the U.S. Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 - 2020.

1.2 The prescriptions of US Sailing will not apply except the US Sailing Prescriptions to rules 67, 76.1.

1.3 If there is a conflict between rules or regulations, other than RRS, the Sailing Instructions will prevail.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising at this event is restricted per ISAF regulation 20.3.1.2 (formerly Category A) pursuant to the ISAF Advertising Code and AMSS Rules. The Organizing Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising.

3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

3.1 Entry is open to all active skippers and owners of the PC Class, the PCC class, all Kettenburg boats built prior to 1985 and all other full keel sailboats and power boats of all wood hull construction built prior to 1985.

3.2 Entries shall be made online at www.sdyc.org/kettenburg. No entries will be accepted after June 22, 2018 at 1800 hours, except at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority. No entry can be considered final until verified by AMSS.

3.3 AMSS reserves the right to refuse entry to boats under RRS rule 76.1 (Exclusion of Boats or Competitors).

3.4 Competitors are reminded that the U.S. Coast Guard has minimum requirements for safety equipment and other gear. By submitting an entry form for the regatta, each owner and/or skipper represents that his/her vessel identified on the entry form is seaworthy and fully compliant with any and all U.S. Coast Guard requirements for the vessel.

3.5 Each owner, skipper and/or co-skipper shall be liable for any and all third party personal injury and property damage claims which pertain to them or their vessel. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid combined single limit watercraft liability insurance, including coverage for Third Party Personal Injury and Property Damage Liability Insurance, in an amount of not less than \$300,000.

4. FEES

All entries and entry fee payments shall be made online, prior to June 22, 2018 at 1800 hours. An online "Registration Form" shall be available beginning at www.sdyc.org/kettenburg.

The entry fees are as follows;

a) **Regatta Entrants:**

Sailboats - through June 15, 2018, the entry fee is \$75.00; after June 15, 2018, the entry fee is \$100; includes slip assignment and use of SDYC facilities for 2 days prior, 3 days of and 2 days after the event, a total of 7 days, one Concours Cocktails entry, Concours Reception, Saturday and/or Sunday racing, and Saturday Rose' & Cheese.

Power boats - \$60 (includes slip assignment and use of SDYC facilities for 3 days prior, 3 days of and 3 days after the event, a total of 9 days, one Concours entry, Concours Reception, Sunday bay cruise, and Saturday event Rose' & Cheese.

b) **Concours Cocktails Only Entrants** - \$25 (includes Concours Entry, and Saturday Rose' & Cheese.

c)

All payments shall be made online by credit card, or charge to member account. Reduced price reception & presentation tickets will also be available online at www.sdydc.org/kettenburg.

If an entry is completed and payment tendered before the early registration deadline of June 15, 2018 and subsequently cancelled or withdrawn in writing to AMSS prior to June 15, 2018, \$50 shall be refunded. After June 15, 2018, no refunds will be made and no refunds will be paid on account of any entries made after that date.

The particulars with regard to race schedules, such as class starting order, warning signals and class start times, will be set forth in the Sailing Instructions.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available online at www.sdydc.org/kettenburg no later than Friday, June 22, 2018. A copy of the Sailing Instructions will also be included in the Skipper's Packet provided at registration.

7. VENUE

7.1 Regatta headquarters will be at the San Diego Yacht Club, San Diego, CA.

7.2 The racing area will be in the Pacific Ocean west of Coronado Island in the area called Coronado Roads and in the San Diego Bay.

8. FLEETS RACING & SCORING

8.1 At the time of online entry, each sail race participant shall declare their intention to sail the races or, alternatively, the Sunday Bay Race only.

8.2 The following classes shall be designated:

- a) PC Class
- b) Racing Class A
- c) Racing Class B

8.3 In the event that four or more Kettenburg boats of a like model/class enter, an additional separate class may be designated by AMSS.

8.4 Class designations, starting assignments and class identification

backstay flags will be made available on the www.sdydc.org/kettenburg website no later than Friday June 22, 2018 and also included in the Sailing Instructions.

8.5 Racing:

Three races are scheduled for entrants, two of which races will be sailed on the Coronado Roads on Saturday, June 23, 2018 and one of which will be sailed in San Diego Bay on Sunday, June 24, 2018 ("Sunday Bay Race").

The results of the Sunday Bay Race will also be re-scored using adjusted AMSS assigned handicaps for purposes of determining the stand alone results of the KCY Charity Cup Race.

8.6 The Low Point scoring system utilizing AMSS assigned handicaps will apply. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No race scores will be excluded.

8.7 Boats designated as Sunday Bay Race-only entries will not be scored for purposes of determining the series results.

8.8 All entries that make a voluntary contribution of \$25 or more to the KCY Charity Cup shall be included in the scoring of the KCY Charity Cup Race.

8.9 Power boats will not be scored.

9. THE COURSES

The courses will be as set out in the Sailing Instructions.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

Spectator and other support boats shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the warning signal until the end of the last race of the day. Specific spectator and support boat instructions will be stated in the Sailing Instructions.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12.2 The race committee intends to use VHF marine radio frequencies to broadcast courtesy information to competitors.

13. PRIZES

13.1 Best of Show prizes (one sail and one power) will be presented for the Concours D' Elegance event. Additional prizes may be presented at the discretion of the judges.

13.2 Prizes will be presented for each competitive race class as listed in the Sailing Instructions.

13.3 The KCY Charity Cup, which is designated as a perpetual trophy, shall be presented to the eligible boat that finishes first, based on corrected time, in the KCY Charity Cup Race.

13.4 All proceeds of the KCY Charity Cup shall be donated by AMSS to the Maritime Museum San Diego – Ancient Mariners Sailing Society Educational Fund.

14. KCY CHARITY CUP

14.1 All sail entries may elect to participate in the KCY Charity Cup Race by making a voluntary minimum contribution to the KCY Charity Cup of \$25.

14.2 All contributions to the KCY Charity Cup shall be in the form of a check made payable to AMSS, or paid by credit card or charge to member account, and presented and/or made no later than by June 23, 2018 at 1900 hours.

14.3 The KCY Charity Cup Recipient for 2018 is the Maritime Museum San Diego – Ancient Mariners Sailing Society Educational Fund (501C3).

14.4 Boats may elect to sail the KCY Charity Cup Race as a non-spinnaker entry. Such an election shall be designated on the boat's entry form no later than June 22, 2018 at 1700 hours and must be acknowledged by the Regatta Chair. AMSS may, solely at its discretion, make upward adjustment in the race handicap of any boat electing to sail the KCY Charity Cup Race as a non-spinnaker entry.

14.5 AMSS may, in its sole discretion, also make an upward adjustment in the race handicap of any boat electing to sail the KCY Charity Cup Race with tan bark or other specially designated sails.

14.6 Any adjustment to race handicaps made by AMSS for non-spinnaker or AMSS specially designated sail entries shall apply to scoring for purposes of determining the order of finishers of the KCY Charity Cup Race only, and not for any other race result determinations.

14.7 Time Limit: The Time Limit for completing the KCY Charity Cup Race is 1600 hours, Sunday, June 24, 2018. All participating boats finishing after the Time Limit will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes RRS 35.

14.8 All boats participating in the KCY Charity Cup Race shall display the official Regatta cup race burgee (to be provided with the skipper's packet), if any, during the Sunday Bay Race.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this Regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.

16. RIGHT TO USE NAME & LIKENESS

By participating in the Kettenburg & Classic Yacht Regatta, a participant automatically grants to the organizers and their sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and

show from time to time at their discretion, any still or motion pictures and/or live, taped, or filmed television/video and other reproductions of him/her and/or their boat without compensation.
