Fredrick owns Emily L a Cape Cod Cat Boat. She was designed by Fenwick Williams and built in New Jersey by Hubert Johnson in 1946. She is 21 ft LOA with a beam of 10 ft and a 1½ ft draft with the centerboard up. Gaff rigged she is built of cedar planks on oak.



CLASSIC YATCH RACE

The Pacific Corinthian Yatch Club of Oxnard California will hold its 6th annual Classic Yacht Race on August 11. This race is for wooden yachts designed before 1952. The event is designed exclusively for wooden yachts of traditional working or cruising design and for vintage racing yachts in the classical style.

The course will be set in the coastal waters between Ventura and the Channel Islands. It will be laid out with the traditional yacht in mind, the major part of the course being sailed "off the wind."

The start will be of the inverted typed with the slower boats first, similar to our Yester-year Regatta. First start will be at 12:00 noon on the 11th, at the Channel Islands Harbor Breakwater.

There will be classes for sloops and cutters, ketches and yawls, and schooners. In addition to trophies for each class, there are perpetual trophies for the winners of each class, overall handicap winner and best elapsed time. There will also be awards for oldest yacht, most distant port, middle-of-fleet and last-to-finish.


