### Saturday May 10<sup>th</sup> *"Race Day"*

The week leading up to Race Day is always very busy and our goal was to reach 40 boats for the 40<sup>th</sup> YYR. This year I had one less thing to worry about since *Sprig* was out of the water and could not be ready in time. Not wanting to miss the history books and help toward the goal I entered *Sprig* and Doug Jones also entered the *Pacifica*. I was happy to be invited to sail aboard ail and I was fortunate to race on Heather and Steve Brownsea's PC 42 *Zest*.

Race day was very busy as usual in the morning with registration and the skippers meeting. At the start of the morning we had 38 entries and I was hoping we might get a few more PC's or other boats to push us up to the goal of 40 boats. Entries held firm at 38.

The conditions on the race course, for most of the race, favored the close winded boats unlike the 2012 and 2013 YYR's that favored the less close winded, higher handicapped yachts.

Highlights of race day for me included:

- Having the merchandise be very well received and sell well.
- The hour between 10-11 am that I was able to catch breadth and get ready for racing.
- Steve Brownsea telling me to keep the helm when it was our turn to start in this pursuit race. This
  immediately took away my bittersweet proceeding thoughts that this was a "Sprig Day" (lots of light air
  upwind.) and I focused on steering *Zest* and fighting the rest of the 7 boat PC fleet, finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> over
  the line, 2<sup>nd</sup> PC and 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall (since correction).
- Having the results ready very quickly and e-mailed off the water to me for printing. A long way since the old days.
- Seeing a nice mixing of the Classes in the Overall Standings.
- Seeing close Corrected Times Overall. 3<sup>rd</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> place within 5 minutes and 9<sup>th</sup> -18<sup>th</sup> place within 3 minutes in conditions that were difficult.
- Anton Schmid for being interested in the AMSS Raffle and Awards Ceremony and having the bravery to come up and accept my invitation to help pass out awards, prizes and for checking the winning raffle numbers and for busting me when I read my ticket in correctly when I thought I was a winner.

There are a few lessons learned and ideas for the 2015 YYR. Stay tuned!




