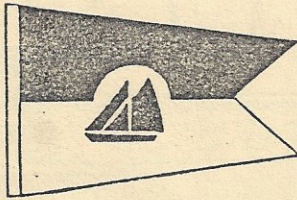

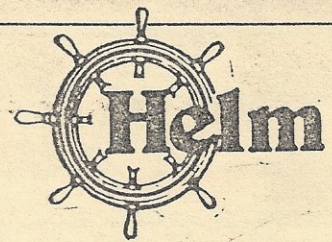

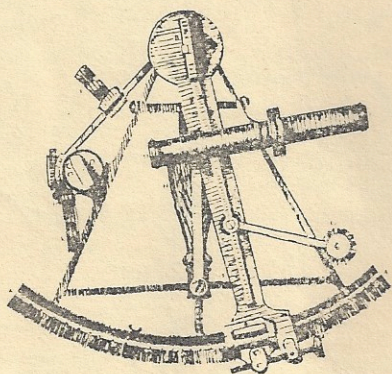
## PROSPECTIVE MEMBERS

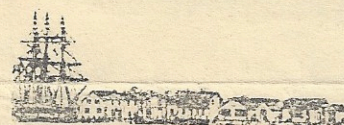
## ANCIENT MARINERS!!

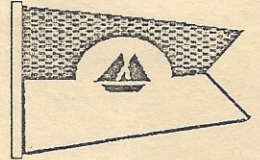
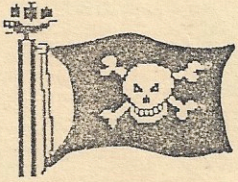

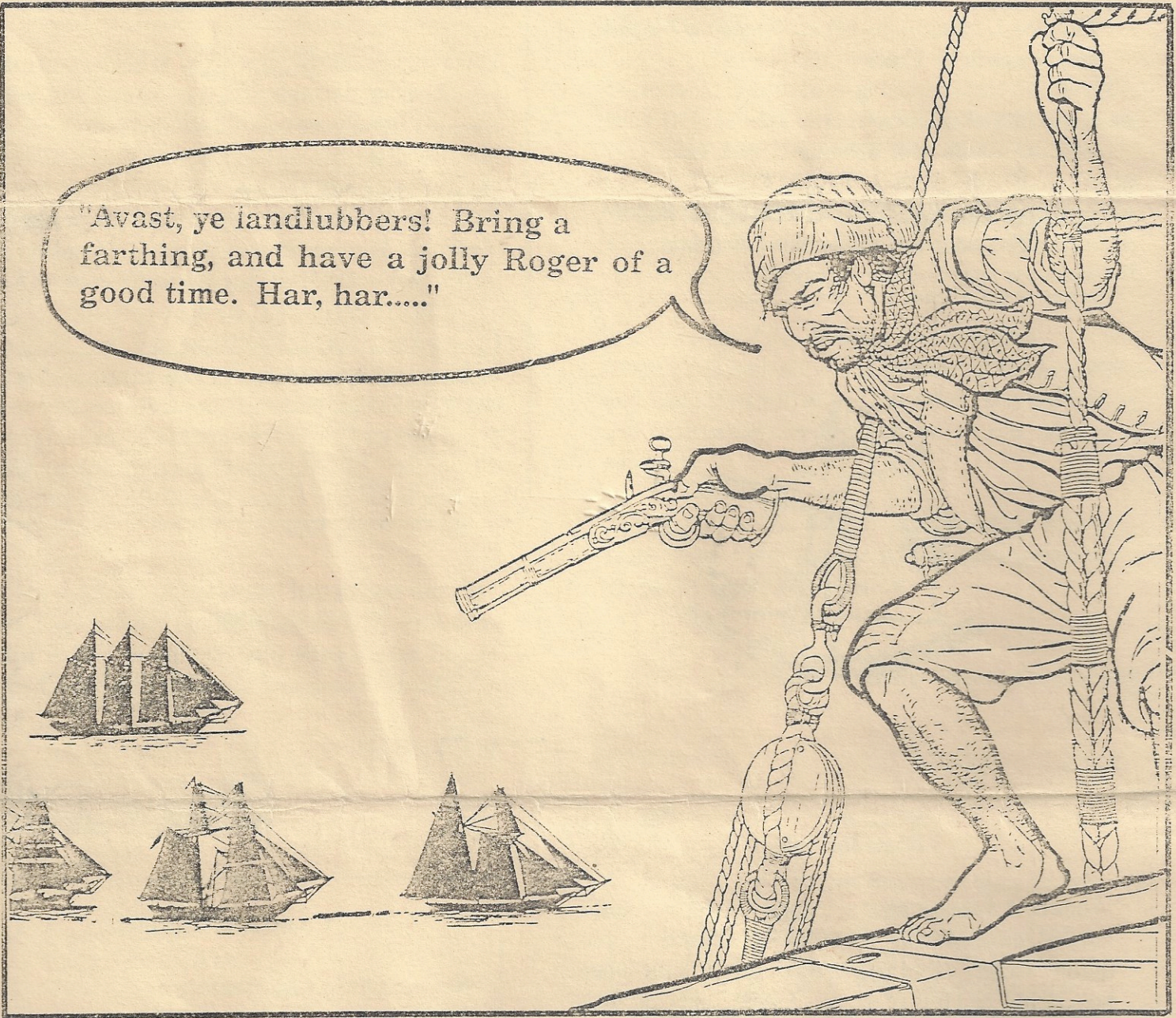
