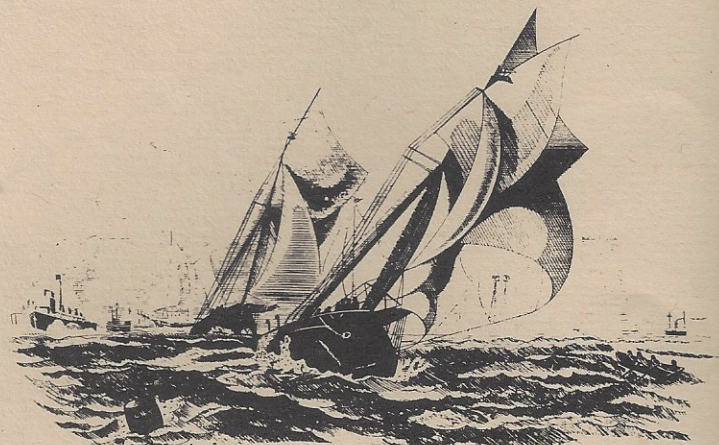
OCTOBER MEETING

AMSS TO REQUIRE PHRF RATINGS FOR RACING FLEETS ?

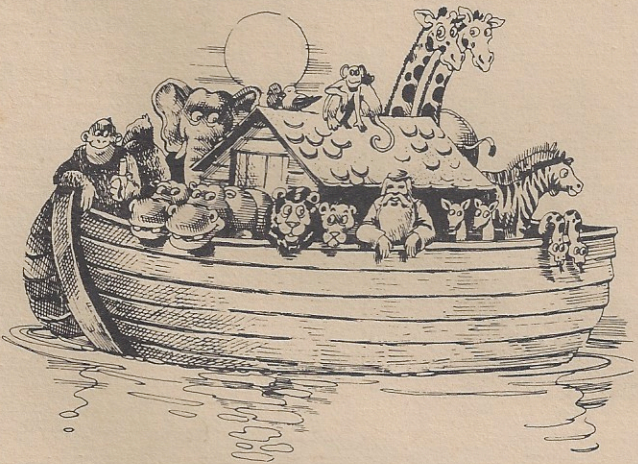
A casual glance at the AMSS events calendar shows that our society has become rather race oriented in recent years. A casual glance at the vessels entered in our classic racing fleets will convince anyone that we have some pretty serious participants involved in our regattas. The handicapping system used by the AMSS has not been able to keep pace with this expanded racing schedule. This has prompted some discussion among various members of the board regarding the possibility of adopting the PHRF handicap standard for the racing fleets and requiring all entrants in these fleets to possess a current PHRF certificate. In order to gauge the general views of the membership, a short discussion on the subject of the PHRF handicap system is planned for our October general meeting. Topics will include how PHRF handicaps are generated, who can get one, how you get one and the cost for maintaining a rating for your yacht. If you have strong feelings regarding this matter, please come and be heard. If you do not agree with this approach, be prepared to present viable alternatives.

Bart and Deanne Grindell own Adriana which is a classic Sparkman and Stephens yawl. Designed in 1949 and built in 1954, Adriana is 57' LOA, 40' LOW with a 12'6" beam and 7'2" draft. She is constructed of double planked Mahogany over Oak frames which are bronze fastened. The frames are also bronze strapped below the waterline. Decks are Teak, cabin house is Honduras Mahogany and the interior is African Mahogany. She is powered by a Perkins 4-154 engine.
