2nd The Fool's Regatta, Well, see the calendar for all the rest,

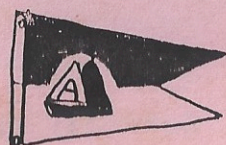
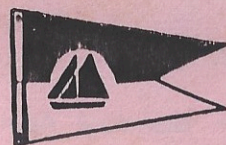
Final Note: The Schooner Bluenose II paid an early surprise visit to our port over Easter, She will be back at a yet to be discovered date.

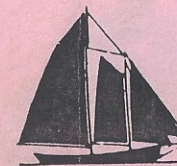
From the Treasurer:

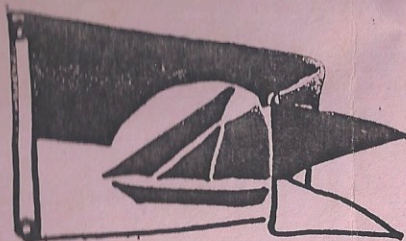
