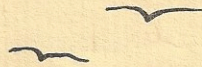

Frost family, Ann, Jack, and boys have taken the Pacifica up the coast to San Francisco and are cruising the Delta.

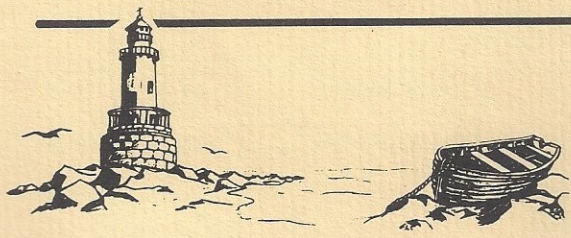


## Pirate Ship
