



All recommendations will be read and discussed. Those with the greatest club interest or potential will be included in the 1997 calendar. Thank you!


AMSS HAS A COMPUTER

Due to you all, 15% of the Wooden Boat Festival's proceeds amounted enough money to purchase Lindy Rae's used 486 computer. Kim Palmer now has use of the computer and is practicing daily. Kim will take over the full editorship of the ALBATROSS from me. I will continue to be the editor and publisher until Kim can take over completely. Unfortunately there was not enough money to buy specialized Software. Software to take voice commands (DragonDictate/Personal Edition \$395, IBM Continuous Speech System \$99 to \$499, Incubero Voice Command \$395) would make the job easier and faster. Screen Readers such as Windows-Eyes (\$495) or Henter-Joyce's Window Wise/Jaws For Windows (\$795) would actually vocalize what was on the screen, would also be wonderful to have.

NEW CHAIR FOR BOAT REGISTRY SUGGESTED

One of the greatest assets we in Ancient Mariners can have, is the overall body of information we hold about classic wooden boats in our region. At the Board of Directors' meeting, on September 9, Vice-Commodore GEORGE WHEELER suggested that AMSS consider establishing a new Chair or Committee to maintain a registry of all known wooden boats on the Pacific Coast. The purpose of the office would be to collect as much information as possible on wooden sailing yachts in our region regardless of condition or membership in AMSS. This could be used for AMSS member recruitment, liaison with others in the wooden boat world and as a means of promoting our festival and other events. To date, no organization on the Coast seems to be doing this.

Although it involves a fair amount of work, this job could be tremendously gratifying and productive. To that end, it is hoped that an AMSS member might be found who would volunteer to take on the project. It would help greatly if he or she is familiar with a software database such as Q&A -- or one that is similar. The task would be to (1) set up the inventory database, (2) collect the Inventory Forms, (3) enter all known AMSS and other wooden boats into the data base, (4) provide information to the society as required for events, (5) publish periodic lists of wooden boats by class and type as required and (6) assist the Membership Chairman in developing information on prospective members and their boats. The term of the job would run concurrently with that of the Board of Directors for each calendar year.

AMSS members, you are cordially invited to pass to Vice Commodore WHEELER any ideas or recommendations or interest you may have in volunteering for the Chairmanship in 1997. (619) 271-8629.
