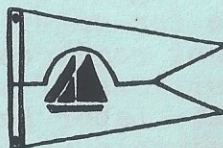

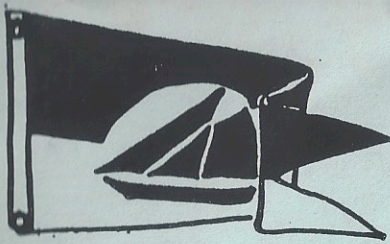
PETTICOAT REGATTA (Saturday, July 19)

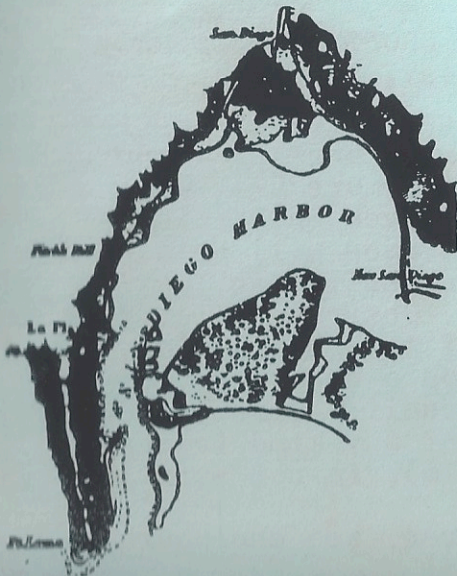

SEA BRIG is not new to the club. She too has been a member before for many years. This ketch is a modified H 28, designed in 1940 and built in 1966.

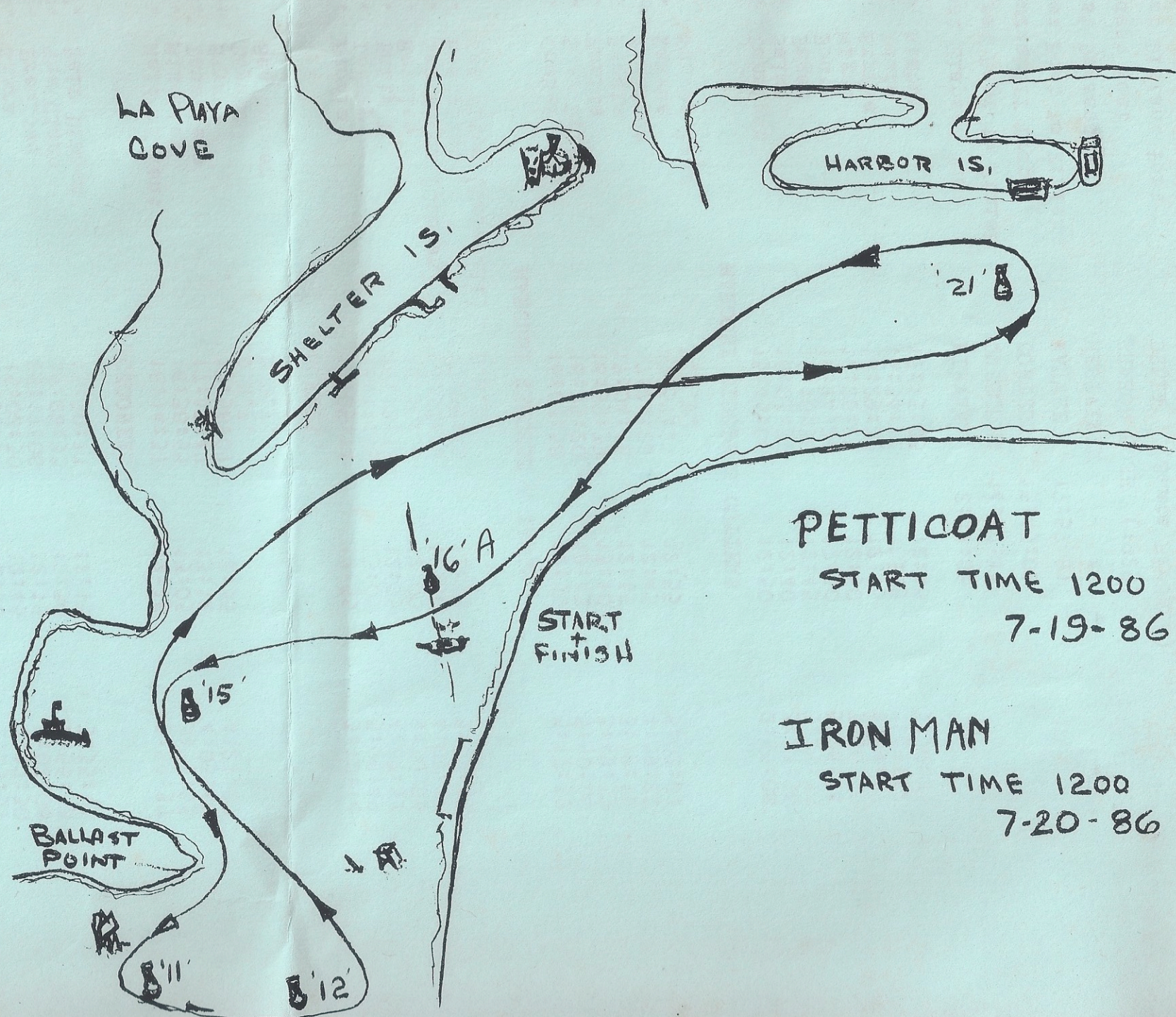
