The KETTENBURG AND CLASSIC YACHT REGATTA celebrates the long history of Kettenburg boats in San Diego, which is now in its 92nd year. This makes this annual event special to classic wooden boat enthusiasts and the Ancient Mariners Sailing Society fleet. The first Kettenburg Regatta was a resurrection of the PC Nationals; it is now open to a wider range of wooden classics and other vessels of classic design that meet the entry criteria. It features a weekend of sailing and socializing, with two Saturday ocean races at Coronado Roads, followed by a Sunday Charity Bay Race which finishes in the channel off the SDYC Cupola. Boats make arrangements to med moor at San Diego Yacht Club for dining and the popular "Concourse d'Cocktails" competition.

Pacific Corinthiuan Yacht Club Ancient Mariners Sailing Society MCNISH CLASSIC YACHT REGATTA

July 31, 2021

For over 40 years, this gathering of Classic yachts has attracted boats from up and down the coast to participate in the 3rd event of the California Classic Yacht Series, the McNish Classic, named to honor founder Dick McNish for his Corinthian spirit and contribution to classic yacht racing. Every entrant has a chance to win, with Trophies awarded in each class, for Best Elapsed Time, for Best Bristol Boat, and, for the First-to-Finish skipper, the coveted "Strathmore Cup" and the skipper's weight in champagne.

Starting at 1200 noon on Saturday, the first boat leads the 'inverted start' of this pursuit race, where slower rated vessels start earlier so that many of the vessels cross the finish line close to each other. The 17 mile regatta course is specifically designed for these classic wooden yachts. With their start off the Channel Islands Harbor breakwater, the boats proceed to round the oil Platform Gina to starboard, and then sail on a reach to the #2 red navigation buoy approximately ½ mi. off the Ventura Harbor entrance; rounding the spar buoy offshore of the Mandalay Power Station to port, they finish on a downwind run to the Committee boat outside the Channel Islands Harbor breakwater. The skippers, crews and enthusiasts then gather at the Pacific Corinthian Yacht Club for a Bar-B-Que and the trophy awards.

This year was notable in an impressive way: Dick McNish turns 94, and Cheerio 11 becomes 90! This beloved 56' yawl, designed by E.B. Shock, was built by Fellows and Stewart, San Pedro, in 1931. And obviously Dick and his crew still have "the right stuff". This year Cheerio's crew included Dick, his son Jeff McNish, faithful navigator Kevin Dickman, Dick's long-term friend Walter Russakoff, Doug Dodge, and Scott Harrison Sr. and Jr. Cheerio placed 4th.

The overall winner was the H-28 ketch "Splinter", skippered by Dan Shepley from Ventura. "Eolo" (a 1980's AMSS member) was 1st in the sloop category, and "La Volpe", a pristine, 95 year old schooner from San Pedro, won Bristol Boat award.
