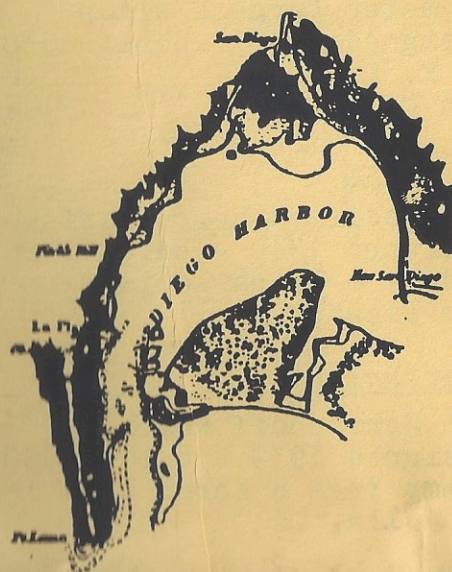

DID YOU KNOW?

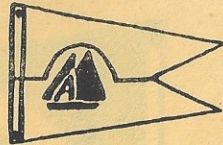
Tom Plotts is spending the summer in Lahaina, Maui, "WORKING" both at the Lahaina Yacht Club and the Whale's Tail.
