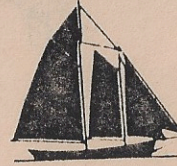
APRIL MEETING

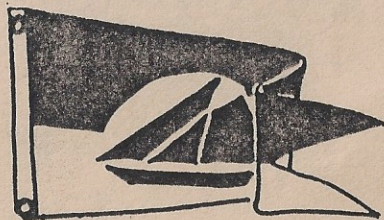
