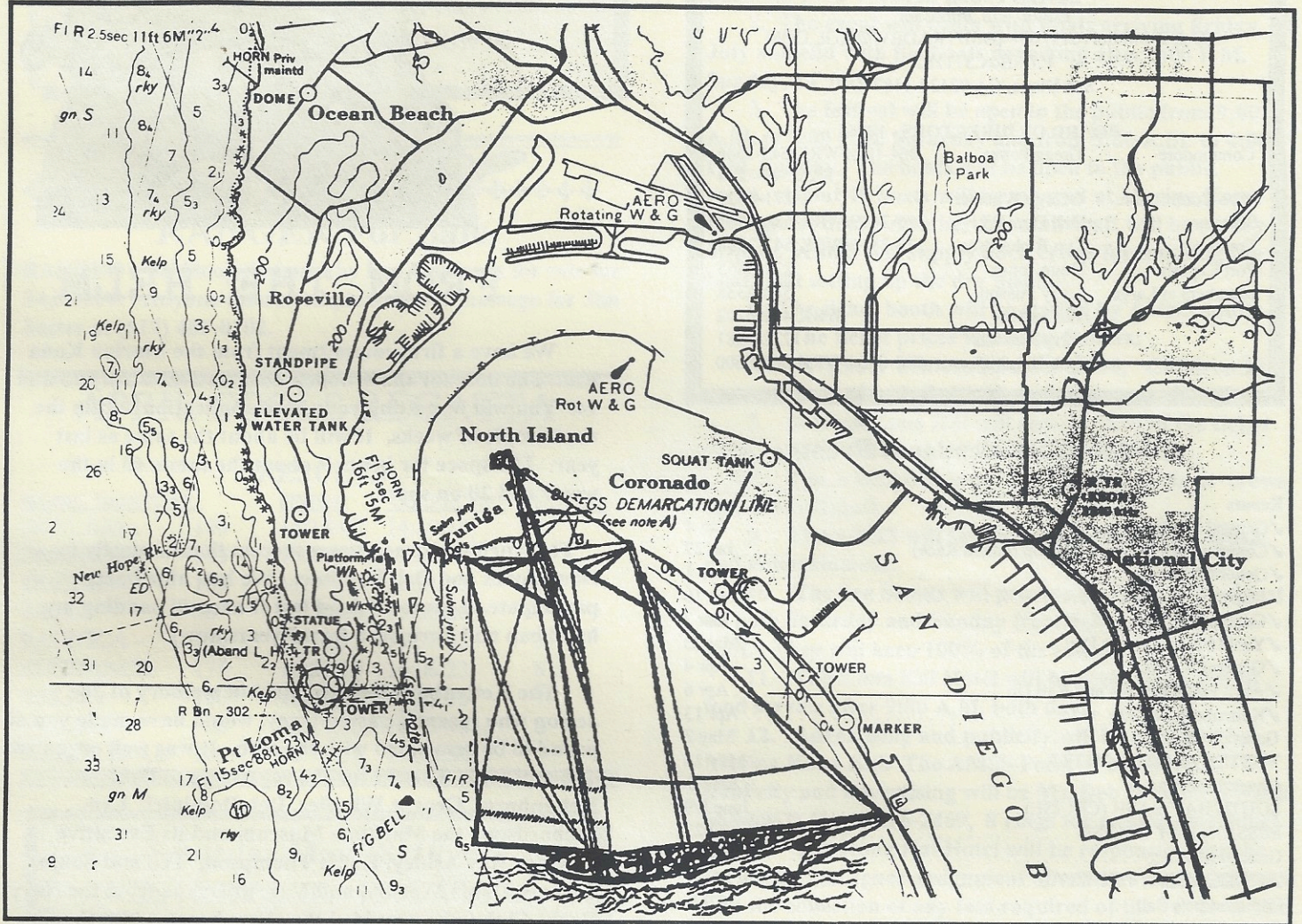

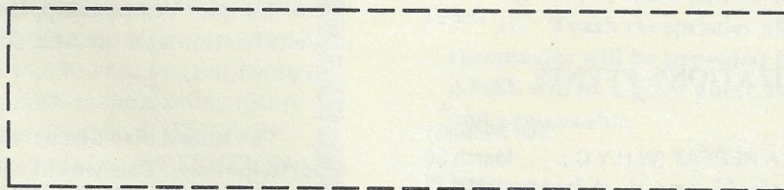
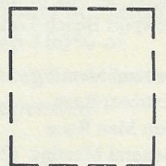

Woodenboat Festival July 13 and 14, 1996

Memorandum of Understanding

Between AMSS and Marina Kona Kai

1. Marina Kona Kai on 1551 Shelter Island Drive will be the official Sponsor of the Ancient Mariners Sailing Societies 1996 Wooden Boat Festival.

2. The event will begin with Boats arriving Friday, 12 July and end with the boats departing after 5:00 P.M. Sunday, 14 July.

3. The festival will be open to the public from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Saturday and from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Sunday. The boats will be open to the public.

4. About 40 boats will be moored at Marina Kona Kai's guest dock. Another 20 small craft will be on dry display. AMSS will supply dock crews for mooring the boats and setting up the dry display.

5. The ticket booth will be staffed by AMSS adults.

6. The ticket prices will be as follows:
Adults \$5.00, Seniors 55/older \$3.00, Children 12 and under \$3.00, & Children 4 and under FREE

7. Marina Kona Kai will receive 25% of the ticket sales. AMSS will receive 75% of the ticket sales.

8. The AMSS will issue Crew Passes for boat crews and Festival staff.

9. The AMSS will assume responsibility for music and entertainment.

10. The Sea Scouts will provide a pancake breakfast on both Saturday and Sunday from 6:30 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. They will keep 100% of the sales.

11. The Kona Kai Hotel will be responsible for all food service after 9:00 A.M. both days.

12. Advertising and publicity will be provided by Marina Kona Kai. The AMSS Point of contact for publicity and advertising will be Ms. Deb Dominici (Work 688-6961; Home 226-2469, 8 rings for message machine).

13. The Kona Kai Hotel will be responsible for the invitation and space assignment of vendors and exhibitors and the collection of any fees required of the vendors. The exception to the fee for merchandise is the AMSS booth. Fees will not be charged for booths or exhibits not selling merchandise. The Kona Kai hotel will keep 100% of vendor fees collected. (In the past, these fees have been kept in the \$20 range to attract small independent business.)

14. Parking will be supplied and controlled by the Kona Kai hotel.

15. Rest rooms will be supplied by the Kona Kai.

16. Trash receptacles and the dumping of trash receptacles will be provided by Marina Kona Kai. The AMSS will be a good guest and try to keep the area clean and presentable.
