# AUG MEETING ON THE BERKLEY by ray ashley

Abstract: Most people think that the culture of sailors and seafaring has always been dominated by charming superstitions and cherished traditions that stubbornly refuse to go away despite its high tech nature and despite a constant assault of modern rationalism that confronts us all. In fact, I'd like to make the case that hundreds of years ago, seafaring was a powerful source of rationalism that swept away an entire world view based on religious dogma and set the stage for the creation of modern nation states that rule through scientific-military-industrial institutions. This complex, which is now so global and pervasive, can be linked in interesting ways to early efforts in solving problems related to seafaring, navigation, and naval warfare. This revolution, which began at sea, was so far advanced that by the time romantic poet S.T. Coleridge coined the term "Ancient Mariner," the sea had seemed even then to have become a backwater of medievalism.
